

### **A4: Clinical Reporting System (CRS) and GPRA 101: Basics of Clinical Quality in the Care of Patients with Diabetes and Obesity**

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The Clinical Reporting System (CRS) is the software that is used by I/T/U sites to report on the GPRA measures. This session will present the basics of GPRA reporting, the relationship between the CRS software and the GPRA measures, and how the CRS software can help sites to improve the care of patients with diabetes and other chronic conditions. We will highlight measures on diabetes, explain some of the basic search logic and share some practical strategies to improve report results using patient lists.
